

The research



INCEPTION		Desk review of internal and external literature to support development of the research framework and data collection tools.
PHASE ONE	February 2016 - January 2017	 Global survey of mentoring programmes across YBI members in 42 countries, 85% response rate 1,068 mentors and mentees from eight YBI members completed an online survey 151 in-depth semi-structured interviews with matched sample of mentors and mentees from eight members Interviews with staff and other key stakeholders
PHASE TWO	February 2017 - March 2018	Data collection repeated Comparative analysis
